# ARMOUR OF GOD SNOW GLOBE

## You will need:

- Modelling clay (such as Fimo®), at least 4 colours
- Baking tray
- Oven
- A pin or skewer
- Small glass jar with screw-on lid
- Water
- Glycerine
- Glitter, sequins and/or seed beads
- Superglue or a waterproof adhesive\*
- A small round pebble

\*You will need the supervision of a leader or parent to help you to use these glues safely.

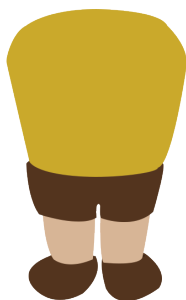
## Instructions

### STEP 1

Follow the guidelines below to design your own clay soldier. Make sure your soldier wears each part of the armour of God and a joyful expression (because he knows the battle has already been won!)

If you've never used modelling clay such as Fimo before, read through the instructions on the packet first. After kneading a small amount of clay (about the size of a marshmallow), begin shaping your soldier.

Remember to keep your soldier small enough to fit into the jar you have chosen. At each point in the process, take extra care to design your soldier's battle gear to remind you of Ephesians 6:13–18!



1. Start with the body, legs and feet.



2. Add the head and belt followed by some arms.



3. Fashion a sword, shield and helmet. Then attach these to your soldier.

## STEP 2

Bake your soldier in the oven as directed by the manufacturer's instructions.

## STEP 3

Use a waterproof adhesive or Superglue to fasten the pebble to the inside surface of the jar lid. Glue your soldier to stand on the pebble. Wait for this to dry.

## STEP 4

Fill your jar with water and add 1 teaspoon of glycerine (this makes the sparkles fall slower in the water). Sprinkle a small amount of glitter, sequins and/or beads of your choice into the water.

## STEP 5

Turn the lid (now holding the soldier) upside down and fasten it to the jar. Tighten securely (you can add glue before tightening if desired).

## STEP 6

Shake your snow globe! Let your soldier remind you to stand firm and thank God for all he's done for you through Jesus!
