PHILIPPIANS MURAL

To create your mural you will first need to decide what material to paint it on.

The options we suggest are:

- Paper
- Art canvasses
- Plywood sheet or bed sheet.

Paper

For paper, download the file 'Philippians Mural'. Print out on A3-sized paper.

This will give you eight pages to hand out to your group to paint and decorate. If you have more than eight in your group, you can cut one or more pages in half.

Once the pages have been completed, use packing tape to stick them together to form one large mural for display. If your printer has left a margin around the edges of the paper, you can cut these off using a guillotine to help the words fit together clearly.

Art canvasses

For art canvasses, download the file 'Philippians Mural'. Print this on A3-sized paper. Then trace each page onto one canvass before giving them to your group to paint and decorate.

Plywood sheet or bed sheet

These options give you a large mural in one piece for your group to paint together.

Download the file 'Philippians Mural Template'. Project this onto your wood or sheet. You can project the image using a computer and projector, or print on an overhead transparency and use an overhead projector. Trace the design using a marker.

Note: If you are using plywood, you may wish to paint a basecoat before you trace the design and start painting as a group.



If you are making this at home we suggest you use paper. Print either the mural on A4-sized paper to create a large mural or print the template on A3-sized paper for a more manageable project.
